



## Form 990 Series Which Forms Do Exempt Organizations File Filing Phase In

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Most tax-exempt organizations are required to file an [annual return](#). Which form an organization must file [generally](#) depends on its financial activity, as indicated in the chart below.

Status	Form to File	Instructions
Gross receipts normally $\leq$ \$50,000 <b>Note:</b> Organizations <a href="#">eligible</a> to file the <i>e-Postcard</i> <a href="#">may choose to file a full return</a>	990-N	n/a
Gross receipts $<$ \$200,000, and Total assets $<$ \$500,000	990-EZ or 990	<a href="#">Instructions</a>
Gross receipts $\geq$ \$200,000, or Total assets $\geq$ \$500,000	990	<a href="#">Instructions</a>
Private foundation - regardless of financial status	990-PF	<a href="#">Instructions</a>
